

Services :

- 1 km away, you'll find the village of Landéda with its businesses (butcher, grocery store, baker, and restaurant) and services (doctor, pharmacy, and dentist).
- A few minutes' walk away, you will find oyster cultivators selling fresh seafood (oysters, crabs, winkles, etc.).
- 2 km away is the port of l'Aber Wrac'h with a sailing and diving club, restaurants, a crêperie and a pizzeria.
- 100 m from the house is ... the beach!

Leisure Activities:

- **Nearby :**
 - the port of l'Aber Wrac'h (2 km)
 - the lighthouse of l'Île Vierge, which is the highest cut-stone lighthouse in Europe (10 km, accessible by canoe from l'Aber Wrac'h)
 - an equestrian centre (5 km)
 - a sailing centre (2 km)
 - a pool (15 km)
- **In Brest :**
 - Océanopolis and the pleasure port
 - festivals depending on the season
 - the Castle and Maritime Museum
 - the Tanguy Tower
 - shopping, cafés and restaurants on rue de Siam and rue Jean Jaurès

- **Other Sites to Visit :**

- the village of Meneham in Kerlouan: a historic 17th-century hamlet of customs and fishermen's houses, recently renovated.
- Le Conquet: a picturesque seaside village
- the beautiful islands of Molène and Ouessant, accessible by ferry from Lanildut or Le Conquet.
- numerous monuments, chapels and fountains typical of Brittany and Breton culture
